# 

## 340B in Nevada

### **Key Points**

- Nevada's low-income taxpayers are required to utilize for-profit pharmacies in Florida.
- PBM owned pharmacy has the most number of contracts benefiting from federal program intended to support needy Nevada taxpayers.
- 60% of the contract pharmacies intended to serve poor patients in Nevada are located in affluent neighborhoods.
- Nevada 340B hospitals (1.93%) provide less charity care than the national average (2.28%).


22% of 340B contract pharmacies for the top Nevada hospitals with the most contract pharmacies are based outside the state. Some of the pharmacies are in Florida.
