

340B in New Hampshire

Key Points

- ▶ New Hampshire low-income taxpayers are required to utilize for-profit pharmacies in Hawaii.
- ▶ For profit chain drug stores have the most number of contracts benefiting from a federal program intended to support needy New Hampshire taxpayers.
- ▶ 77% of the contract pharmacies intended to serve poor patients in New Hampshire are located in affluent neighborhoods.
- ▶ New Hampshire 340B hospitals (1.58%) provide less charity care than the national average (2.15%).

59% of 340B contract pharmacies for the top New Hampshire hospitals with the most contract pharmacies are based outside the state. Some of the pharmacies are in Hawaii.

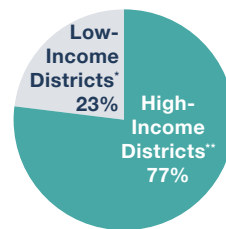
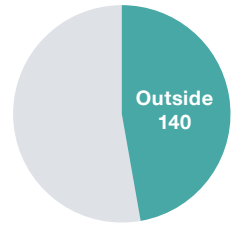

- Total number of contract pharmacies intended to serve needy patients in New Hampshire – **295**
- Number of contract pharmacies intended to serve New Hampshire’s needy patients that are located outside of New Hampshire – **140**

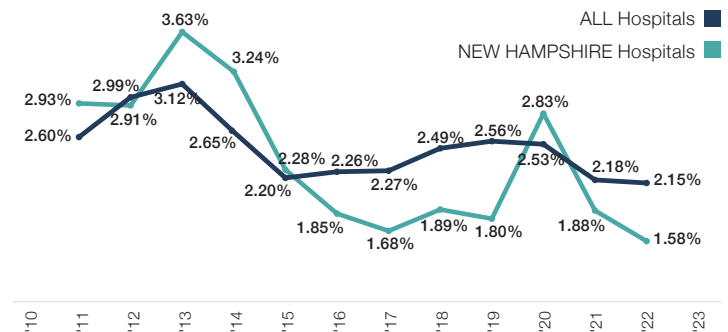


77% of 340B pharmacies supposedly serving the poor are in affluent neighborhoods in New Hampshire.

- **7.2%** of the population living in poverty
