- Pennsylvania's low-income taxpayers are required to utilize for-profit pharmacies in Hawaii and California.
- Pharmacy Benefit Management (PBM) owned and chain drug store contract pharmacies benefit from a federal program intended to support low-income Pennsylvania taxpayers.
- More than half of contract pharmacies intended to serve poor patients in Pennsylvania are located in affluent neighborhoods.
- Pennsylvania 340B hospitals (0.95%) provide less charity care than the national average (2.28%).


Top 340B contract pharmacies in Pennsylvania serving low-income patients are owned by for profit PBMs and retail chain drug stores.

More than half of 340B pharmacies supposedly serving the poor are in affluent neighborhoods in Pennsylvania.

- 11.8% of the population living in poverty

- ** High-Income Districts house districts where the percentage of the population living in poverty is below the average state poverty percentage

33% of 340B contract pharmacies for the Pennsylvania hospitals with the most contract pharmacies are based outside the state. Some of the pharmacies are in Hawaii and California.
