Key Points

PIONEER HEALTH

- Wisconsin's low-income taxpayers are required to utilize for-profit pharmacies in Hawaii and Florida.
- Pharmacy Benefit Management (PBM) and for profit chain drug store contract pharmacies benefit from a federal program intended to support low-income Wisconsin taxpayers.
- More than half of contract pharmacies intended to serve poor patients in Wisconsin are located in affluent neighborhoods.
- Wisconsin 340B hospitals (0.89%) provide less charity care than the national average (2.28%).

34% of 340B contract pharmacies for the Wisconsin hospitals with the most contract pharmacies are based outside the state. Some of the pharmacies are in Hawaii and Florida.


